Rules

1. How the awards work

SoR members making a nomination for SoR UK Rep of the Year are also nominating their choice for a regional/country award. For example, if you live in the south-east, you will send your nomination to the south-east regional committee (see below). From the entries received, the committee will choose a regional winner, which they will forward to SoR headquarters as the regional entry for the UK title.

2. Nominations

Any member of the Society of Radiographers can nominate an accredited Society of Radiographers' Representative – Industrial Relations, Union Learning, Agenda for Change, or Health and Safety.

Non-members are not eligible to make nominations. The accredited representative must agree to being nominated and, if they should win either their regional/national award, or the UK award, should be willing to attend a presentation ceremony at the Society's Annual Delegates Conference to be held in Leeds, 25 – 27 April 2010.

Nominations must be made on the official nomination form overleaf. It is available to download from the front page of the members' area of www.sor.org.

Nominations must be received by your regional committee/national council by 29 January 2010 to be considered.

Each regional committee/national council will choose a regional/national winner from the nominations received. They will then forward the details by 15 March 2010 to Gill Smith at SoR headquarters in London.

From the nominees forwarded by the regional committees/national councils, a panel of judges (including the Society's president and a representative of Thompsons Solicitors, the award's sponsors) will select an overall UK winner. The judges' decision will be final.

Only nominations received from the regional committees/national councils will be considered for the title SoR UK Rep of the Year.
